

Skyland UMC Going Forward Quick Reference

Worship Guidelines Beginning May 30th:

- Practice excellent hand hygiene
- If you are experiencing fever, cough, aches, or other significant health symptoms, please remain at home
- Maintain 3 feet of distance between households
- Reservations are no longer required
- Seating is open, please maintain 3 feet between households
- Congregational singing will resume with masks
- Pew cushions, hymnals, pew Bibles, and handouts will return
- Length of worship services will be extended
- Children will be invited to come forward for children's time
- All doors may be used to enter the building
- All small groups are free to make their own decisions as a group regarding masks. On Sundays masks will still be required during interior transit to and from your meeting space
- Windows will be opened or closed on a Sunday-by-Sunday basis at the discretion of the ushers and/or the Trustees
- Exiting by all available exits is still encouraged

Overall Guidelines

- All small groups, committees, and ministry teams may resume using the building by scheduling time and space through the church office
- Masks are not required outside
- Masks are required inside the building whenever children and youth aged 18 or younger are present.

Upcoming Services

- May 30th – here comes the big step forward! This 10:30 service in the sanctuary will be open to all who wish to attend – NO reservations. (The previous Eventbrite link sent out is no longer needed.) Masks required. No limits on seating – please act responsibly. The children will be encouraged to come forward for the Children's sermon.
